

Winter Gold Racing 4 - Chorale Du Nord

We have shares available in a 3-year-old filly, Chorale Du Nord who is by Choeur Du Nord x Hembra, who is a half-sister to Nurse Susan who was 4th in the Red Rum Mares Hurdle at the Cheltenham Festival and has won two Class 2 Hurdle races this season.

The plan for Chorale Du Nord will be to run in the Autumn in the National Hunt Juvenile Hurdles Series. Chorale Du Nord has been in training through spring in preparation for the coming autumn.

Syndicate Details:

The syndicate will be made up of 20 equal (5%) shares.

Each share will cost £2,000 and this will cover the time period from now until 1st July 2025. There will be no additional costs within this time period.

From 1st July 2025 there will be a monthly charge of £150 per person for the training of the horse. The idea of the syndicate is to run as much and for as long as possible.

Syndicate shareholders will receive 100% of prize money.

Monthly Visits to the yard to see your horse working on the gallops.

Alne Park Stud will 'own' the horse so there is no third-party person to keep happy with limited runs etc.

The £2000 per share will be maintained for any late joining member. So, whilst the filly might not run until the autumn there is no benefit to someone joining later on in the term (like just before she runs).
